

Sprout Program Descriptions 2007

Spring Program

2pm - 4pm: Arrive. Children are encouraged to play games with the others, receive help with individual projects, read, or explore the center's resources. A snack will be provided at this time.

4pm - 5pm: Enrichment Hour. Example activities include guest experts, guided discussions about giftedness, creative/inventive problem solving, and in-depth explorations of a particular topic.

5pm - 6pm: Homework and Free Choice. Children will have the opportunity to complete their homework with the help of qualified teachers. Then, much like the first hour, children are free to work on an activity of their choosing or delve further into the topic discussed in the Enrichment Hour.

6pm: Depart

Summer Program

The summer program will run June 25 - August 17. You can choose to enroll for one week, two weeks, three weeks, or the entire summer. The weeks do not have to be consecutive. Unlike the school year programs, children will come each day for the entire week of the session. The session will be from 9 am - noon, and depending on demand we may offer an extended day option until 2 pm.

9am - 10am: Arrive. Children are encouraged to play games with the others, receive help with individual projects, read, or explore the center's resources.

10am - 11am: Enrichment Hour. Example activities include guest experts, guided discussions about giftedness, creative/inventive problem solving, and in-depth explorations of a particular topic.

11am - Noon: Free Choice. Much like the first hour, children are free to work on an activity of their choosing or delve further into the topic discussed in the Enrichment Hour. A snack will be provided during this time.

Noon: Depart

We understand that children may have other commitments, so the programs are designed to allow children to arrive during the first hour and depart during the last hour, at times that work for them.

Back to School Program

The week of August 20 - August 24 will be our Back-to-School program to help children gear up for school. A book club, spelling bee, writing activities and math problem solving are a few of the planned activities.

Fall Program

The Fall Program will begin with the 2007-2008 school year, starting on September 3. The structure will be identical to the Spring Program. More information is available in the Parent Handbook.
